

Teluk Memali Mosque



The relocation, conservation and preservation

of Kampung Teluk Memali mosque from Kg. Gajah to Ipoh, Perak in Malaysia. The relocation and restoration work of this 100+ years heritage building was done with considerable care to bring the past glory to the present. Credit mainly to ATSA Architects. GORI was chosen after many trials and finally GORI 91 was chosen due to its non peel and crack characteristic making it easier for future maintenance. GORI 22 was used to treat all wood with signs of degradation, followed by priming with GORI 44 and then finished with GORI 88 or GORI 91. GORI 51 was also used on the interior wooden floors. Future maintenance would only require 1-2 coats of GORI 88 or GORI 91.
